### A MESSAGE FROM PROVINCIAL PRESIDENT GRAEME JOHNSTON QUEEN OF SURREY

This morning, the Queen of Surrey crashed into an outer portion of the Langdale dock. The crew and passengers remain on the vessel pending tug-boat assistance and further inspection. There are no reported injuries.

The extent of damage to vessel and dock is not yet fully known, but will likely put the vessel out of service for an extended period.

The Company and Union have arranged for a divisional inquiry into this matter. The Union's appointee is Chief Officer Elizabeth Proulx of Local 18. The Union also anticipates an investigation by Transportation Safety Board.
