Job Description: Chief Electrician - Cutter Suction Dredger

Reports to: Chief Engineer.

Position Summary: The Chief Electrician is responsible for overseeing and executing the maintenance, overhaul, and repair of all electrical installations on board. This includes managing electrical systems, ensuring safety and compliance, and maintaining clear and accurate records. The role requires a significant level of expertise and experience in electrical systems, particularly within marine environments.

Responsibilities:

- **Electrical System Management:** Conduct and supervise the maintenance, overhaul, and repair of all on-board electrical installations, including electrical power generating plants, main auxiliary and emergency switchboards, all panels and control desks, and starting and distributing equipment.

- **Abnormality Reporting:** Report any immediate abnormal findings or emergency situations to the Chief Engineer and follow orders given by officers in charge during such events.
- **Drill Participation and Training:** Engage in established drills and training for emergency preparedness and safety prevention. Lead practical training sessions for the crew to familiarize them with risk prevention and safe operation of electrical and electronic equipment.
- Workshop Supervision: Manage the planning for maintenance and repairs carried out by the engineers in the workshop. Ensure the correct and prompt execution of the Chief Engineer's orders, supervise all workers in the workshop, and maintain the inventory of spare parts and tools in AMOS.
