# **Authorization requirements**

Authorization and training for the position are specified in the crew qualification matrix PR707.

#### Assigned tasks, with responsibility for the following:

- 1. Own bridge watch.
- 2. Loading and discharge, own watch.
- 3. Ballast Handling, own watch.
- 4. Keep inventories and maintains lifesaving, fire fighting and other emergency equipment according to Job card in Consultas.
- 5. Identify safety equipment deficiencies and report such to Master.
- 6. Responsibility for carrying out inspections, tests and exercises according to Job card in Consultas
- 7. Responsible that navigation lights are working during his watch and in charge of renewing the bulbs if it is found defect.
- 8. Responsible of GMDSS Radio Equipment, check and test of battery and distress alert equipment.
- 9. Each crewmember is responsible to fill in the "Rest / Work hour" all columns.

### Duties and responsibility essential to safety at sea and environmental protection:

- 1. Duties in accordance with the "Alarm list" for the vessel.
- 2. Duties according to the "Shipboard Marine Pollution Emergency Plan" (SMPEP)
- 3. Promote the concept of Furetank safety and environmental excellence.

## Shipping line specific training and education for the position:

- 1. Introduction, training and education on board before taking up the position, covering a period of 1-3 days as an extra member of thecrew.
- 2. Introduction to and training in the ships Safety Management System, by Furetank Familiarization form.
- 3. Training and education on board by 2<sup>nd</sup> Mate in preparation and presentation of charts / **ECDIS** before a new voyage.
- Training and education on board by 2<sup>nd</sup> Mate in passage planning and chart corrections / ECDIS procedure.
- 5. Training and education in 2nd officer duties in order to be prepared for higher position
- 6. Safety awareness + Risk Assessment.
