Job description - Motorman, Whatchkeeping Engine Rating and other Engine Ratings

Authorization requirements

Authorization and training for the position are specified in the crew qualification matrix [PR707](#).

Assigned tasks, with responsibility for the following:

1. Routines and work according to Chief Eng. Orders
 2. Each crewmember is responsible to fill in the "Rest / Work hour" all columns.
 3. "Motorman weekly routines safety Equipment" The battery-check to be included a log over the battery-density.
- * Every six days the motorman's daily routines is transferred to 3:rd Engineer.
 - * Every twice week the motorman's weekly routines is transferred to 3:rd Engineer.
 - * Duties to be transferred back to motorman when no 3:rd Engineer is onboard.

Duties and responsibility essential to safety at sea and environmental protection:

1. Duties in accordance with the "Alarm" list for the vessel.
2. Duties in according to the SMPEP or SOPEP.
