

# Job description - Ordinary Seaman (OS)

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#### **1** Training requirements

Training requirements and certificates for the position are specified in <u>PR707</u>.

### 2 Duties assigned, with responsibility for the following

- 1. At sea: taking watch on bridge when on-board as extra crewmember. Taking watch together with CHO for training to become a skilled helmsmen and later a skilled AB
- 2. Mooring: assist at the assigned mooring station under supervision of OOW.
- 3. Cargo operation: follow the Checklist for AB on Watch after training by ordinary AB and approval by CHO.
- 4. Assisting C/O, AB / pumpman with cargo stripping, blowing / cleaning cargo lines, super stripping, purging of cargo cofferdams, tank cleaning etc., to reduce the workload for all involved individuals.
- 5. When OS on- board as extra crew above the safe manning, one ordinary AB to be appointed by Master/CHO to work day time and if found needed used for mooring operation.
- 6. The extra OS on board are in line with owner's intention to reduce the workload on the AB in the minimum safe manning.

Each crewmember is responsible to fill in the "Rest Work hour" all columns.

### 3 Duties for safety at sea and environmental protection

Duties in accordance with the alarm list and. Shipboard Marine Pollution Emergency Plan (SMPEP).

### 4 Shipping company-specific training and education for the position

Introduction to and training in the ships Safety Management System, by Furetank Familiarisation form.
