Job Title: Barge Officer - Split Hopper Barge

Reports to: Directly to the Master in situations where a Master is present onboard. In their absence or incapacity, the Barge Officer is the highest authority on the vessel.

Position Summary: The Barge Officer serves as a key figure on a Split Hopper Barge, adept at managing navigational tasks, overseeing the dredging operations, and ensuring the vessel's performance aligns with safety and environmental regulations. As second-in-command, the Barge Officer steps into a leadership role when required, coordinating the crew and operations seamlessly.

Responsibilities and Authorities:

- **Navigational Management:** Responsible for the watch on the bridge, guiding the vessel's course, and monitoring maritime traffic. Executes all aspects of navigation with a keen understanding of the local hydrographical conditions to ensure a safe passage.
- **Operational Execution:** Manages and directs the dredging operations, ensuring the excavation and relocation of materials are conducted efficiently and safely. Takes proactive measures to maintain vessel stability during loading and unloading of dredged materials.
- **Crew Coordination:** Maintains discipline on board, oversees the well-being and training of crew members, and ensures adherence to safety protocols.
- **Command Responsibilities:** Fully assumes command on barges without a Master, upholding the company's standards and maritime laws.

Normal Repetitive Tasks:

- **Daily Operations:** Conducts and supervises daily navigational duties, ensuring the barge follows the planned route and operates within designated parameters.
- **Dredging Supervision:** Monitors dredging techniques and makes adjustments to optimize performance and mitigate any risks to safety or equipment.
- **Maintenance Oversight:** Enforces stringent safety measures and supervises the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) for all onboard tasks. Leads a technical team to manage significant repair works, ensuring the vessel's machinery and equipment are in prime condition. Carries out regular inspections of dredging equipment, maintaining a log of operational status and repair needs.
